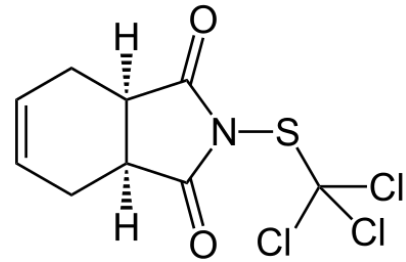


Captan 50%WP

Captan is the name of a general use pesticide (GUP) that belongs to the phthalimide class of fungicides.

Function:

It is used to control diseases on a number of fruits and vegetables as well as ornamental plants. It also improves the outward appearance of many fruits, making them brighter and healthier-looking.



Uses and Dosage:

Crop	Pests	Rate of use	Application
Tomato	Tomato leaf mould	937.5-1406.25 g/ha.	Spray
Tomato	Tomato early blight	937.5-1406.25g/ha.	
Cucumber	Cucumber anthracnose	937.5-1406.25 g/ha.	
Hot pepper	Pepper anthracnose	937.5-1406.25g/ha.	
Pear trees	Pear scab	714-1000 mg/kg	
Apple trees	Apple ring rot	625-1250 mg/kg	
Grape	Grape downy mildew	833-1250 mg/kg	
Strawberry	Strawberry gray mold	833.3-1250 mg/kg

Captan is cited as Group B2, a probable human carcinogen by the EPA.
